REGISTRATION OF PROPERTY ON THE LISTED LAND USE REGISTER (LLUR)

I am writing to inform you that the environmental status of Stage 1 of the Prestons Road South Development has been reviewed by senior staff at the Contaminated Sites Team. The property encompassed by Stage 1 of the Prestons Road South Development includes specific areas identified on the Listed Land Use Register (LLUR) as having had potentially contaminating activities identified on the Hazardous Activities and Industries List (HAIL). These activities include:

- Persistent pesticide bulk storage or use •
- Storage tanks or drums for fuel, chemical or liquid waste •
- Asbestos products manufacture or disposal

Environmental assessment reports detailing investigation and remediation activities performed on the development have been reviewed and the non-reserve properties located within HAIL activities have been registered on the Listed Land Use Register (LLUR) under one of two categories: At or below background concentrations or Below guideline values - Residential. Assignment of one of these categories could mean that significant levels of contamination were never identified or that any contamination identified has been remediated.

In the case of Stage 1 of the Prestons Road South Development any contamination identified in site soil at concentrations above what is considered acceptable for residential land use has been excavated and removed either off-site or to designated reserve areas. Therefore, regardless of which category has been assigned to your property, we have determined that any contamination previously identified on your property no longer poses a risk to human health.

Some properties within the development have not been associated with a HAIL activity and therefore have no LLUR sites associated with them. Although such a property may have been included in one or more investigations it will have no assigned category on the LLUR. Lack of a category does not mean that the property is contaminated. Since there is no reason to believe that these properties are contaminated, they are therefore automatically classified as suitable for residential use.

Information about sites on the LLUR is used in several ways.

1. By district and city councils to fulfil their functions relating to contaminated or potentially contaminated land

Information about your site will be made available to your relevant district or city council. They are expected to use this in any Land Information Memorandum (LIM) or Property Information Memorandum (PIM) for your property. They may also use the information for district planning purposes.

2. For responses to site-specific enquiries received by Environment Canterbury

We regularly receive requests for information about sites in the region. If a person with a specific interest in your property (for example, a potential purchaser) requests information about your site from us, we would use the information presented in the site assessment report(s) as the basis for our response.

3. By Environment Canterbury to establish priorities for managing sites

Based on the information available and the assigned category, your property is suitable for residential use and there is **no need for further investigation**.
